**World Youth Day:** Think about World Youth Day 2011 in Spain with Pope Benedict XVI. World Youth Day is a major pilgrimage in your faith. We will journey with the diocese on the extended pilgrimage August 7 - 22, 2011, through Barcelona (Sagrada Familia Basilica) to Montserrat (Nearby cave of Manresa where St Ignatius wrote much of the Spiritual Exercises), Manresa (St Ignatius museum), Lourdes (Our Lady of Lourdes Grotto), Boly Mill (Birthplace of St Bernadette), San Sebastian (Beach of La Concha), Pamplona (old city Ciudad Antigua and walk on the Camino de Santiago), Puente la Reina, Segovia (Cathedral), and finally Madrid for the main World Youth Days with Pope Benedict XVI. Cost estimate is \$3,000. \$300 deposit is due to the parish office by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Pilgrims must be 16 before August 7, 2011 (14 if a parent is a chaperone). ## The Revised Edition of the Missale Romanum

Pope John Paul II issued a revised version of the *Missale Romanum*, (the Roman Missal), the ritual text for the celebration of the Mass, during the Jubilee year of 2000. Since that time, the work of translating this edition of the *Roman Missal* has been underway. The final sections of the English translation were approved by the Bishops of the United States in November, and the final *recognitio* of the complete text from the Holy See is expected early this year. The USCCB has prepared a website at [www.usccb.org/romanmissal/](http://www.usccb.org/romanmissal/) to help us prepare for the transition to this new translation of the revised *Roman Missal*. The website contains helpful resources for the faithful, for the clergy, and for parish and diocesan leaders.
