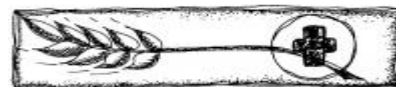

## World Youth Day

St William of York Parish has one open reservation for World Youth Day 2011 in Spain with Pope Benedict XVI. World Youth Day is a major pilgrimage in your Faith. We will journey with the Diocese on the extended Pilgrimage August 7 - 22, 2011, through Barcelona (Sagrada Familia Basilica) to Montserrat (Nearby cave of Manresa where St Ignatius wrote much of the Spiritual Exercises), Manresa (St Ignatius museum), Lourdes (Our Lady of Lourdes Grotto), Boly Mill (Birthplace of St Bernadette), San Sebastian (Beach of La Concha), Pamplona (old city Cuidad Antigua and walk on the Camino de Santiago), Puente la Reina, Segovia (Cathedral), and finally Madrid for the main World Youth Days with Pope Benedict XVI. ## Thirty-First Sunday In Ordinary Time October 31, 2010

### First Reading: Wisdom 11:22—12:2

In this reading, we are reminded of the love God feels toward every creature, or else He would not have created them. God shows mercy on our sins and hopes we will repent and have faith in Him.

### Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 1:11—2:2

Paul tells the Thessalonians that God will make them worthy of His call, so that they can be glorified in Christ. Paul also tells them he is unsure when Christ will come again, but urges them not to believe people who falsely state that Jesus has returned.

### Gospel: Luke 19:1-10

Zacchaeus, the wealthy chief tax collector in Jericho, was very excited when Jesus came to town and asked to stay with him. People were angry that Jesus would go to a sinner's home. Zacchaeus then told Jesus he planned to give half of his belongings to the poor, and repay any person he had cheated. Jesus was delighted since His mission was "to search out and save what was lost."

TEST TIME: 8:30 a.m. - 12 Noon

FEE: \$35.00

ELIGIBLE STUDENTS: Any 8<sup>th</sup> grader attending public school, non-Catholic private schools or Catholic schools outside the Arlington Diocese.

REQUIREMENTS: Students must fill out a High School placement test registration form. You may get a form at the following website under "School Forms" <http://www.arlingtondiocese.org/catholicschools/parents.php>. The registration form and fee must be submitted to the test site no later than Wednesday, December 1, 2010.

For students who are prevented from taking the test on December 4<sup>th</sup>, there will be one additional testing date as noted below:

Saturday, January 8<sup>th</sup> at **BI, DJO, PVI** and **JPG** or Saturday, January 22<sup>nd</sup> Snow Date, at **BI, DJO, PVI** and **JPG**
