In celebration of the vocation of Our Holy Father and his faithful service to the Church, our diocese will offer a total of over sixty hours of Eucharistic adoration with the intention of the sanctification of clergy and an increase in vocations to the priesthood. In order that we may unite with the universal Church in prayer St. William of York will offer Eucharistic Holy Hour in Honor of Pope Benedict XVI's 60th Anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood on Friday, July 1, 2011 from 3:00 PM to 4:00 PM.

Dress at Mass

However, we must carefully consider the appropriateness and modesty of our dress, particularly when it comes to attendance at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. We come to Mass to celebrate the most sacred act of worship for Catholics. Our attire should reflect reverence to the presence of our God. What is good for the beach or the tennis court is not proper for a wedding or a solemn graduation ceremony. Similarly, shorts, halter tops and t-shirts are not proper for the worship of our God. Please consider this before you come to Holy Mass.

First Reading: Exodus 34:4b-6, 8-9

The Lord appears to Moses on Mount Sinai and proclaims to him that he Lord is a "merciful God...slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity."

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 13:11-13

Paul exhorts the Corinthians to live in peace and harmony, and for the first time, invokes the Blessed Trinity.

Gospel: John 3:16-18

In this beautiful passage, Jesus tells Nicodemus that God loved his people so much that he "gave his only son." Jesus reveals to Nicodemus that anyone who believes in him will not die but will enjoy life with him for all eternity.
