Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace and peace to you in the Risen Lord Jesus!

I am writing regarding our second collection next weekend (May 14-15, 2011), which will benefit our retired diocesan priests. This collection, held annually, helps to care for our current and future retired priests. It is vital that we pray and support our priests who have dedicated their lives to serving God's people. Our priests work tirelessly to bring the presence of Christ to the faithful.

In our diocese, there are currently 15 retired priests; over the next 10 years, an additional 21 priests will reach retirement age. Last August, we opened the *Saint Rose of Lima Priests Retirement Villa*, a residence designed to accommodate the priests from the Diocese of Arlington who have dedicated their lives in service to the Church. This beautiful and restful 15,000 square foot two-story home includes both common areas and private residences for eight priests.

This second collection will assist our priests in multiple ways. Primarily, these funds will assist the ongoing operational needs and expenses of the *Saint Rose of Lima Priests Retirement Villa*. Additionally, this collection will also aide the post-retirement health care, nursing home care, and the priest pension fund.

I ask you to consider prayerfully participating in next week's second collection to benefit our beloved priests who serve Christ and our Diocesan Church so faithfully.
