We have been reporting Sunday collection (debt collection) receipts each week in the bulletin. The amounts reported only included amounts received in the Sunday collection baskets. Some parishioners mail their contributions to the parish office and others contribute monthly by means of a bank debit or by credit card. These contributions have not been included in the amounts reported in the bulletin. In order to provide a more complete reporting and to show how contributions compare with the parish budget, we have revised the reporting format. The new format, which appears below, shows first collection contributions through September. This chart will be included in the bulletin once a month.
