### First Holy Communion Dress Code

#### BOYS DRESS CODE:

- Suits of Navy or Black with white shirt, white tie
- Sport coat with navy, khaki, gray, or white trousers (No shorts)
- Dress shoes (No sneakers).

#### GIRLS DRESS CODE:

- White dress (below the knee) or longer, **shoulders must be covered.**
- White socks, or pantyhose.
- White shoes or sandals with back strap. **NO** flip-flops or mules.
- **Veils** are optional, should be white and simple (be careful and practical, it should fit securely), jewelry should be minimal. Communicants should not be carrying anything in their hands, i.e. Pocket book, Mass book, rosary, or gloves.
