The dress code for 1st Communion is as follows:

BOYS: White Shirt, white tie, a sport coat (suits may be worn); navy, khaki, gray, or white trouser (No shorts), dress shoes (No sneakers). Nothing in hands (no Mass books or rosaries, etc.)

GIRLS: White dress (at least below the knee), cap sleeves or longer, shoulders must be covered, white socks, or panty hose, white shoes or sandals with back straps, no flip-flops or mules. Veils (not mandatory) white, simple, (be careful and practical, it should fit securely), jewelry should be minimal. Nothing in hands (no pocketbooks, Mass books or rosaries). No gloves worn during Mass.


