When I was a teenager I converted to the Catholic faith after missionaries visited my village. I received lots of harsh words from my fellow villagers who did not believe in the same God I did so I moved to Canada. I died when I was 24 years old. In 2012 I was canonized the first Native American saint. I am called “Lily of the Mohawks” and am patron of the environment and ecology. Who am I?
