Name the Saint!

My feast day is November 13th. I was born in Italy to a large family with 13 children. When I became an adult I knew I wanted to be a nun, but my poor health stood in my way so I helped my parents and siblings out on our family farm until my parents died. After their death a priest asked me to teach in an all-girls school. I founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart whose mission was to help poor children in schools and hospitals. In 1889 I was asked to go with 6 other nuns to America to help the Italian immigrants. In America I founded many schools, hospitals, and orphanages to help the Italian immigrants. In 1949 I was canonized by Pope Pius XII making me the first American citizen to become a saint. I am the patron saint of immigrants. Who am I?

High School Placement Test

8th grade students attending public schools or non-Catholic private schools who are interested in attending Catholic High Schools in the Diocese of Arlington need to take a placement test. The date, time and locations are listed below.

TEST DATE: Saturday, December 6, 2014
(Snow Date - December 13, 2014)

TEST SITES: Bishop Ireton High School, Alexandria
Bishop O'Connell High School, Arlington
Paul VI High School, Fairfax
Saint John Paul High School, Dumfries

TEST TIME: 8:30 A.M. - 12 Noon

FEE: \$35.00

ELIGIBLE STUDENTS: Any 8th grader attending public school, non Catholic private schools or Catholic schools outside the Arlington Diocese.

REQUIREMENTS: Students bring the \$35.00 fee and must fill out a High School Placement Test Registration Form (available under "School Forms" at <http://www.arlingtondiocese.org/catholicschools/parents.php>). The registration form must be submitted to the test site **no later than Thursday, December 4, 2014.**

For students who are prevented from taking the test on December 4, 2014, there will be one additional testing date as noted below:

Saturday, January 10, 2015 Winter HSPT at **BI, DJO, PVI** and **JPG** or Saturday, January 17, 2015 Snow Date, at **BI, DJO, PVI** and **JPG** Test Time: 8:30 A.M. - 12 Noon
