My feast day is July 5th. I was born and lived most of my life in Italy. I was raised by a single mother after my father died. Though she had to work to feed us, she saw that I got a good education. I studied medicine and eventually became a doctor. However, as I healed people's bodies I also started to wish I could heal their souls as well. After several years I was ordained a priest and spent my days preaching in churches and on street corners about God. So many other men wanted to do the same as me so I formed the Barnabites order. While the Church was losing Catholics, I worked hard to bring them back to the faith by encouraging them to receive the sacraments often and attending exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. I worked so hard that I died from exhaustion at age 36. I am usually pictured with a symbol of the Eucharist. Who am I?
