My feast day is June 6<sup>th</sup>. I was born in raised in Germany in the 11<sup>th</sup> Century. Most of my life I lived very well and never lacked for anything. I always chose the easy and most pleasurable options without thought to how it was hurting my soul. It took a thunderstorm and a fall off my horse to knock some sense into me. After this I completely changed my life around, choosing the most difficult options and choosing to walk barefoot rather than ride a horse as I preached about God throughout the German countryside. I received holy orders and eventually was appointed as archbishop. I had so many people that wanted to help me that I knew were not called to holy orders that I had lay people help with my religious order. This is one of the very first times lay people were included in helping with the Church. Who am I?
