Name the Saint!

My feast day is June 19th. I was born into a wealthy family in Florence, Italy. My father died when I was young, leaving me to be raised by my mother and an uncle. When I was 15 I refused marriage which is what my mother and uncle wanted me to do. Instead I became a Servite Tertiary. After my mother died, I moved away and gathered a group of women who, like me, wanted to pray and do good works. I created a rule of life for my group of women and am considered the foundress of the Servite nuns. I am patron of sick people and sickness. Who am I?

Religious Education is an 8 year program; 1st - 8th grade.

All rising 3rd grade students and those in special sacrament classes are expected to return in the fall to continue their education in the Faith. The years in between the second and seventh grades are instrumental years for building upon and expanding knowledge and understanding of your faith.
