Name the Saint!

My feast day is April 7th. I am from a wealthy French family. At 10 years old I knew I wanted to be a priest. I had the choice of being a canon of the Church which was a special privilege and comfortable life for priests, but I chose instead to give my whole inheritance (400,000 francs) to feed the poor during a famine. I am most known for establishing schools for young boys and teaching them in their native language (instead of Latin). These schools then prepared the boys for life after school by teaching them about different trades. However, I realized that for a school to be successful the teachers had to be well educated too so I began the first teachers' college. Education was such a passion of mine that in addition to beginning these new schools I also introduced the concepts of "Sunday School", "reform school", and "grade levels". Pope Pius XII named me "patron saint of All Teachers of Youth". Who am I?
