Eventually he was swayed by my steadfast faith and converted to Christianity. One of my most notable characteristics is my ability to promote peace. Several times during my life I intervened in disputes and mediated a peaceful resolution. After my husband died, I went to live at the convent of the Poor Clares and led a quiet life where I cared for the sick, provided food for the hungry, and donated much of my money to the poor and religious groups. Several of my ancestors are also saints, including my great-aunt St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Who am I?

It is mandatory that all parents register with the parish office (659-1102) before the class.

Narthex Expansion Project

We met with the architect again on June 9th. The goal of the meeting was to review the plan we had selected from our previous meeting in February, and to determine if the changes we had requested could be done and still keep the project at an acceptable and reasonable cost estimate, as was directed by the Diocese in July 2016. The architect provided a "concept drawing" that incorporated those changes we requested. Although the overall estimate did increase from \$1.0M to \$1.4M, we feel the changes we requested strongly justify this increase. Last Monday, June 12th, we submitted a letter to Bishop Burbidge requesting permission to award a contract to the architect to develop detail design drawings and construction documents. The cost for this work would be approximately \$326,000. In the vestibule of the church are two concept sketches of the work we hope to do.
