Week 4 of 8 from Bishop Burbidge

Our Catholic teaching affirms the right of governments to defend their borders and to regulate migration. In the United States, however, a combination of deficiencies in our existing immigration laws and inconsistent enforcement of those laws has produced an untenable situation. There are millions of undocumented workers who have lived and worked here for years, begun families, and made the U.S. their home, but have no viable pathway to citizenship.

# Narthex Expansion Project

We met with the architect again on June 9<sup>th</sup>. The goal of the meeting was to review the plan we had selected from our previous meeting in February, and to determine if the changes we had requested could be done and still keep the project at an acceptable and reasonable cost estimate, as was directed by the Diocese in July 2016. The architect provided a “concept drawing” that incorporated those changes we requested. Although the overall estimate did increase from \$1.0M to \$1.4M, we feel the changes we requested strongly justify this increase. Last Monday, June 12<sup>th</sup>, we submitted a letter to Bishop Burbidge requesting permission to award a contract to the architect to develop detail design drawings and construction documents. The cost for this work would be approximately \$326,000. In the vestibule of the church are two concept sketches of the work we hope to do.
