It was in my nature to bring peace so I was called on a lot by the pope and other rulers to broker peace between warring countries. At one point I was thrown in prison and it was here that St. Francis spoke to me and told me to join the Franciscan Friars. I did and turned my life toward teaching others about God. I wrote against heresies and was a great preacher. Seeing that people would not come into churches to hear homilies, I began to preach in the public square. My largest crowd was 126,000 people. My nickname was "Soldier Saint" as I led an army into battle at age 70. I am patron saint of jurists and military chaplains. Who am I?
