He made it possible for me to go to study to be a priest at the seminary in Turin, Italy. I had a great talent that drew young people to me. I used this talent to encourage poor young city boys to join me on Sunday outings in the country where we would play games, go to Mass, and have a religion class. Eventually my group of boys grew to be so large that I was able to buy a house where they could all stay at and learn these lessons. I had a great reputation as a preacher and even wrote books about Christian faith for boys. To be a Christian during my life was not liked among a lot of people, but even my enemies grew to like all the good things I was doing for the young boys. I am patron saint of boys. Who am I?
