Sacrament of Penance:

Sacrament of Marriage:

The Diocese of Arlington Requires at least a six (6) month preparation period prior to any wedding taking place. Please contact the Parish office and schedule an appointment with one of our priests to begin the process. These sessions will cover the basic teaching of the Catholic Church regarding marriage and the family.

Sacrament of Baptism:

Requirements:

- ❖ Must be a registered parishioner for at least 3 months prior to setting a date.
- ❖ Must attend a Baptism Preparation class.
- ❖ Sponsor letters for Godparents must be submitted prior to setting a date.

Spanish Baptism Preparation class is normally held on the 2nd Saturday of **every month** at 8:30 AM in the Brent Room. Please call the parish office to sign up for the class.

ALTAR BOY SOCIETY OF ST. OF ST. JOHN BOSCO:
